Critical access hospital support



- Rural 9 Network
- Utah Medicaid statewide payment-to-cost percentage
 - 128% overall for in-patient hospital and outpatient hospital
 - Rural hospital reimbursement ratios range from 96% to 197%
 - Only 2 rural hospitals have ratios less than 100%
- Beaver upper payment limit program
 - \$40 million remodel that includes a community education center, fitness area
- Payor mix:
 - lower Medicaid enrollment vs. higher commercial insurance enrollment
